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Lester G. "Red" Bursey Outstanding Senior Athlete Award: In 1925, Lester "Red" Bursey arrived in Cooperstown following his graduation from Springfield College. He devoted the next 43 years to the students and the Athletic Department at CCS. In honor of his lifetime of dedication, the Cooperstown Sports Booster Club annually presents the Lester G. "Red" Bursey Outstanding Senior Athlete Award. This award is given to CCS Seniors whose athletic career best exemplifies the characteristics that create an outstanding athlete. Specifically, we look for characteristics of versatility, passion, intense competitive drive, and superior athletic ability. This year's winner will receive a plaque in recognition of their accomplishments and their names will be inscribed on the Bursey Trophy.

**Robert D. Snyder Community Service Award:** The Robert D. Snyder Community Service Award will be given annually to one or more senior athlete(s) who have shown a dedication and commitment to their sport and the Cooperstown community through volunteer service throughout their time at Cooperstown Central School. This annual award is named in honor of Robert "Bob" Snyder, Cooperstown Central School Class of 1977, who served as President of the Cooperstown Sports Booster Club for 30 years. For decades, he led by example through volunteerism and community service through organizations such as Cooperstown Little League and Cooperstown Youth Soccer, both of which have had long-lasting benefits to the Cooperstown Athletic program and the thousands of athletes his leadership and service impacted.
